Language contact often occurs along borders or as a result of migration. The transfer of words or phrases can be one-way or two-way. Chinese has influenced Japanese, for instance, though the reverse has not largely been true. Two-way influence is less common and is typically restricted to specific regions.

Definition and Examples of Language Contact

Language contact can occur at language borders, between adstratum languages, or as the result of migration, with an intrusive language acting as either a superstratum or a substratum. Language contact occurs in a variety of phenomena, including language convergence, borrowing and relexification.
