Telephoto lenses are the ones that feature image stabilization. This is because longer focal lengths suffer worse from camera shake than from shaky hands. The rule is to shoot at a shutter speed no lower than your focal length. A 50 mm lens has a limit of 1/60th of a second, and a 300 mm lens has a 1/250-1/300 range.
