### Course Syllabus: RLL 6120 Developmental Reading ...

Reading Skills II is the third course in a three-course sequence designed to prepare students to deal successfully with college-level reading. Students who have not passed the reading portion of the THEA or THEA alternative (T-COM) must enroll and participate in a developmental reading course until they satisfy the THEA reading requirement.

### Syllabus - College Reading Strategies

In order to pass the course, a student must demonstrate reading/study competencies on the final exam and earn at least a C (i.e., at least 76%) of the possible points for the course. All assignments will be graded and your total score at the end of the semester will be out of 1000 points.
