In presenting the first (1934) edition, Denniston set himself to cut down the etymological discussion which characterised his German predecessors in the field. He was concerned to illustrate how particles work and how they nuance Greek language within the corpus of surviving work. His primary aim was "literary, not grammatical or etymological".

Greek uses many more particles does than written English. Many of these Greek particles act essentially as sentence adverbs, serving either as sign posts that mark the underlying grammatical sentence structure, or providing an emotional emphasis to a word, clause, or sentence that expresses the mood or attitude of the writer.

Thus, it was a form of the Byzantine text that appeared in the first printed edition of the New Testament in Greek, published by the great scholar Erasmus of Rotterdam in March 1516. This edition was based on a mere seven Greek manuscripts copied in the eleventh, twelfth, and fifteenth centuries, none of which contained the full New Testament.

A Syntax of the Greek New Testament - Participles

Koine is also the language of the Christian New Testament, of the Septuagint (the 3rd-century BC Greek translation of the Hebrew Bible), and of most early Christian theological writing by the Church Fathers. In this context, Koine Greek is also known as "Biblical", "New Testament", "ecclesiastical" or "patristic" Greek.
