The North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria (OOSC) is the pass-fail criteria for roadside safety inspections. The purpose of the criteria is to identify critical safety violations. Those violations render the driver, vehicle and/or motor carrier out of service until the condition (s) or violation (s) are corrected or repaired.

CVSA's New 2020 North American Standard Out-of-Service ...

The 2020 North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria (OOSC) was published by the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) and went into effect on April 1. The OOSC is the decision-making guide officers use to determine if a driver or vehicle with a violation will be allowed to leave the inspection site.

The North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria identifies critical vehicle inspection items and details the criteria that can prohibit a motor carrier or driver from operating a commercial motor vehicle for a specified period of time or until the condition is corrected. An example of the former standard is hours of service violations. FMCSR code references in the North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria are simply recommendations to help inspectors find an appropriate citation. Other violation codes may be more suitable for a specific condition.

"Pass Inspection" means that during a Level I, Level V or Level VI Inspection, there are no critical violations, according to the North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria. If no critical violations are detected during the eligible inspections, a CVSA decal is applied.
